Scholarships are awarded by the “See Ya Later” Foundation to two **McMinnville High School** graduates each year in honor of Scott Banke, an inspirational young boy who lost his battle with cancer in 2001 at age 12. Scott attended Adams, Grandhaven and Patton Middle School in McMinnville, and would have graduated from MHS. He was a positive young man that touched many lives. In addition to the scholarships, the Foundation offers kids camps (including a football camp with Denver Broncos, U of O and Dayton standout Dante Rosario) and Seeds of Hope, an outreach to families in medical crisis.

Any school district employee or community member may nominate students.

To nominate a student:

Please include your name and the full name of the student you are nominating.

- How does the nominee exemplify kindness and compassion for others?

- How does the student demonstrate commitment to community?

- What are the nominee’s plans for continuing education?

Review process:

The “See Ya Later” Committee will review nominations and finalists will be interviewed. Two \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded at the Senior Awards assembly at McMinnville High School in June 2012. All awards will be sent directly to the educational institution once the student has been accepted and enrolled.
