A \$3,000 scholarship will be awarded to one 2012 **Newberg High School** graduate in honor of Scott Banke, an inspirational young boy who lost his battle with cancer in 2001 at age 12. Scott attended McMinnville schools. He was a positive young man that touched many lives throughout Yamhill County.

In addition to scholarships, the Foundation offers kids camps (including a football camp with Denver Bronco, U of O and Dayton standout Dante Rosario) and Seeds of Hope, an outreach to families in medical crisis.

Any school district employee or community member may nominate students.

Please answer, citing examples, the following questions either on this form or in a letter.

Please include your name and the full name of the student you are nominating.

- How does the nominee exemplify kindness and compassion for others?

- How does the student demonstrate commitment to community?

- What are the nominee’s plans for continuing education?

Review process:

The “See Ya Later” Scholarship Committee will review nominations and finalists will be interviewed. One \$3,000 scholarship will be awarded at the Senior Awards assembly at Newberg High School. All awards will be sent directly to the educational institution once the student has been accepted and enrolled.
